

## Pet Friendly FAQs

Thinking about bringing your dog to stay at Caley Hall? Here's some frequently asked questions to help you prepare for your stay.

Where are dogs allowed within the hotel?

In your bedroom,  
On the wooden floor in bar area,  
In the dog friendly restaurant,  
All outside patio areas.

Where are dogs not allowed within the hotel?

In the main restaurant,  
Any carpeted areas in the bar/lounge,  
Non-dog friendly bedrooms.

Do dogs need to be kept on a lead?

Yes, within the hotel areas.

What do you provide for dogs?

Dog beds in the bar,  
Water bowls in the bedroom.

What do I need to bring for my dog?

All your doggy essentials including their bed.

How many dogs are allowed in one room?

Up to 3 dogs per room (depending on size).

What room type do I need to book?

Dogs are welcome in specific Classic rooms, Small doubles and some Family rooms. We also have a dog friendly 2 room family unit and 1 superior room.
